

# United Way 50/50 Raffle Rules

## Rules of the Draw

1. No one under the age of 18 shall be eligible to purchase a raffle ticket or win a prize.
2. All tickets will only be sold in the province of Ontario.
3. The raffle is comprised of one stub draw for a 50/50 contest on:

Date	Number of Tickets Available
December 17 <sup>th</sup> 2023; 11:30 AM	10,000

4. The ticket price will be; **1 Ticket for \$5.00**
5. Tickets will be sold in advance of the draw **from Wednesday November 15<sup>th</sup> 2023 at 8:00 AM to December 14<sup>th</sup> 2023 up until 11:59 PM.** Tickets will be specific to the draw and the prize will be referenced on the ticket.
6. **A single winning raffle ticket will be drawn on Sunday December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 11:30 AM.**
7. Draw location will take place at: **Unifor Local 707 Union Hall, 475 North Service Rd. E., Oakville, ON., L6H 1A5**
8. The winner of the prize shall be determined by reference to the Name, Location (department or retiree classification) and a telephone number on the stub. The winner will be announced at the draw and will be published on the Unifor Local 707 website ([www.uniforlocal707.org](http://www.uniforlocal707.org)) and on bulletin boards in each department. If the winner is not present, the winner will be notified by telephone or by letter to the number or location provided.
9. **The winner must provide an original copy of the winning ticket.** Along with the winning ticket, the winner must provide their name, address and phone number with photo identification for our report sheet. Payment will be made by cheque.
10. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is 50% of the gross total sales for the draw. If the winner cannot provide photo identification, the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
11. Unifor Local 707 shall be responsible for awarding the prize and making all reasonable efforts to contact the prize winner in accordance with the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario's Rules & Regulations.
12. If the prize is not claimed it shall be secured or placed in safekeeping for a period of six months from the date of the draw. If by that time the prize has still not been claimed the prize money shall be donated to a beneficiary approved by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.
