We are sharing with you the details of the **1st Annual Tabs for Charity: A Shift vs B Shift Tab Challenge!** This is an exciting and meaningful initiative that can bring the workplace together for a great cause, aimed at making a difference in the lives of children with disabilities. Here is a quick summary of the challenge:

## **Key Details:**

- Host: Unifor 707 Women's Committee
- Challenge Period: January 2025 December 2025
- **Objective:** Collect the most pop tabs throughout 2025. A Shift and B Shift will compete against each other to see which can gather the most tabs.

#### **How It Works:**

- **Collection:** Tabs can be dropped off into the specially marked bins at the **Halton Action Centre** (labeled "Tab Collection Here").
- Scoring: When your team bin is full, it counts as 1 point for the shift that filled it.
- Winner: The shift with the most points at the end of 2025 will win bragging rights for collecting the most tabs.

### Why Participate?

The collected tabs will be recycled and the funds generated will be donated to **The Robert Hampson Tabs for Kids Fund**, which recycles the aluminum to raise funds for children's adaptive equipment. This helps support families in need, making a significant impact on the lives of children with disabilities.

#### **Past Impact:**

- Tabs Collected: 105 million
- Equipment for 20 children, including:
  - o 13 wheelchairs
  - Van lifts and accessible van seating
  - Hospital beds, adapted tricycles, and more.
  - Surgery for cleft palates
- Aluminum Recycled: 72,069 lbs.
